Reporting directly to the Production Coordinator and department heads, General Theatre Technicians will assist with load-in, load outs, and other stage and theatrical duties as assigned.

**About the Position:** General Theatre Technician is an entry level position that will provide technical support for production related tasks at The Laguna Playhouse, including, but not limited to, scenic changeover of set, flown soft goods, and technical elements, constructing scenery, hanging and focusing theatrical lighting, loading and unloading trucks and containers, running audio cabling, and sometimes the opportunity to work as crew during tech or production runs

### Qualifications and Responsibilities:

- Under supervision of the Production Coordinator or department leads, theatre technicians will assist with the load-in, load-out, or technical rehearsals as assigned.
- Basic knowledge and experience working with scenic elements, stage sets, props, lighting, and audio equipment.
- Knowledge and experience working with power tools and other technical theatre equipment.
- Will assist with the load, installation, and strike of scenic components, lighting, AV components, or audio components.
- Ability to work with various materials, including lumber, paint, steel, and acrylics.
- Experience working as a stage hand in a live entertainment setting is a plus.
- Ability to take direction, follow instructions, and read technical drawings without consistent oversight.
- Must be comfortable working in heights of up to 25 feet.
- Ability to lift 50 lbs.

### Physical Requirements of the Position:

- The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. This position is very active and requires standing, walking, bending, kneeling, stooping, crouching, crawling, and climbing all day. The employee must frequently lift and/or move items over 35 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.
